

## 1.Introduction

## 2.Installation

#### Installation requirements

- a. Do not plug any other appliances into the outlet with your sauna.
- b. Install the sauna on a completely leveled floor.
- c. Do not spray the exterior with water. If the floor is damp, install a floor separator to keep the sauna high & dry.
- d. Do not store flammable objects or chemical substances near the sauna.

## 3. Installation procedure

## **Corner Style**

1. Place the bottom panel in the desired location of your sauna. SEE FIG-1

2. Align the back panel (left and right) with bottom panel corresponding battens; make sure they are in line. SEE **FIG-2** & **FIG-3**.

## **Straight Style A**





15. After ensuring all steps are completed correctly, connect the power and test the sauna to ensure proper functionality. Next, position the top board over the sauna unit, aligning it appropriately. Thread the power plug through the designated opening in the top board. Retrieve the screws provided with the assembly, and using a cross screwdriver, securely fasten the top board to the sauna unit.

## **Operation**

#### 1.Precautions

- a. Ensure all circuitry and the plug meet necessary requirements.
- b. Set the temperature and time to a comfortable level, typically 30 minutes at 120°F.
- c. Hydrate by drinking a cup of water before the sauna session.
- d. After continuous use for 2 hours, shut down the sauna for one hour.
- e. To prevent burns, avoid touching the heating element.

#### 2.Operation:

- a. Only plug the sauna into a dedicated 110-120 volt wall outlet. Avoid sharing the outlet with other appliances. Use the ON/OFF switch to activate the sauna, ensuring to unplug it when not in use.
- b. Adjust the temperature using the 'temperature' button. If the 'heat' light is illuminated, every time the '+' button is pressed the temperature will increase by one degree. Holding the button for three seconds the temperature will adjust rapidly. Decrease the temperature similarly by pressing the '-' button. Once the sauna reaches the desired temperature, the 'heat' light will turn off.
- c. Control the interior light by pressing the 'light' button to toggle it on and off.
- d. If the sauna feels too stuffy, open the ceiling vent or the front door for ventilation.
- e. After completing your sauna session, remember to turn off the unit and unplug the power cable.
- f. To set the timer, press the 'function' button until the 'time' button blinks. Use the '+' and '-' buttons to set the timer from 5 to 90 minutes. Holding either button for three seconds will rapidly adjust the timer. When the display shows '05', the timer will sound, and the sauna will automatically shut off after 5 minutes. To extend your sauna session, reset the timer accordingly.

## **Warnings:**

#### **1.Safety Precautions:**

- a. To prevent fire hazards, refrain from drying clothes or leaving towels in the sauna.
- b. Avoid burns or electric shocks by refraining from touching or using metal tools on the net cover of the sauna stove.
- c. Exercise caution around the sauna's light bulb; refrain from touching it while in operation. If the bulb needs replacement, switch off the sauna, wait until it cools down, and then proceed to change the bulb.
- d. Refrain from using the sauna if you have any of the following conditions:
  - Open wounds
  - Eye diseases
  - Severe diseases
  - Elderly or weak individuals, especially those with existing illnesses. Pregnant women and infants are strictly prohibited. Children above the age of 6 may use the sauna under adult supervision.
  - If you have a medical condition directly affected by temperature, consult a doctor before using the sauna.
- e. Pets should not be placed inside the sauna.
- f. Do not use the sauna if you are under the influence of alcohol.

## **Maintenance:**

## **Cleaning:**

Use a wet towel to clean the faceplate, or if necessary, use a small amount of hand soap mixed with warm water. Clean the sauna room using a wet cotton towel, then dry it with a clean, dry towel.

Avoid using benzene, alcohol, or strong cleaning chemicals on the sauna. Note: Any chemical that can damage wood material will harm the sauna and its protective layer.

Do not leave the sauna running for more than 2 hours continuously.


### **Transportation and Storage:**

During transportation, avoid exposure to rain, snow, or strong collisions. Store the sauna in a dry environment; avoid damp locations.


Color Therapy Lights (options) Some models will include color therapy lights (or chromo lights). The color lights are operated by the remote control only. Press any color on the remote control to turn the lights on and select a color. Press the "Cycle" button (lower right button) to cycle through the colors randomly. Press the "Power" button to turn the lights off.



**AM/FM CD player** The CD player will be pre-installed on the sauna. There are two parts to help removing the CD player if needed (2 L-shaped metallic pieces – image on the right).

### Power Button (On/Off) (1)

This button turns the sauna on or off.

#### Heat Light (2)

The light will be on when the heaters are working. When the sauna reaches its desired temperature, the heaters and the Heat Light will turn off.

#### Timer Control (3/4)

Use (+) or (-) to increase or decrease the sauna timer. It will count down until 00 and shut down the heaters.

**Continues Working Time** If you would like to keep the sauna working continuously (no time limit), press and hold both (+) and (-) buttons, the display should show two dashes (--). To start the timer again, just click on one of the Timer Control buttons.

**Temperature Control (5/6)** Use the (+) or (-) to increase of decrease the sauna temperature. The heaters will turn off when the sauna reaches its desired temperature.

**Fahrenheit and Celsius Lights (7/8)** These lights indicate what measurement is used to display the temperature. To switch between Fahrenheit and Celsius, press and hold both Temperature Control buttons.

## **Control sauna by Mobile phone**

The system can be conveniently controlled remotely using a mobile phone.

- 1. For users outside the country, they can download the "Cloud Intelligence" app from the Android or Apple App stores and install it on their mobile phones.
- 2.User Registration: Overseas users have the option to register using either their QQ or mobile phone number. During registration, they can select their registered address corresponding to the country where the device is located.
- 3. Setting Up the Distribution Network:

This is a crucial step, and currently, there are two methods available for setting up the distribution network.


#### Method: Direct Distribution Network in the App


Ensure that the mobile phone is connected to the same network as the device. Within the "Cloud Intelligence" app, click on the following settings for network distribution.



Once the interface appears, the device is in standby mode (when power is off). Press and hold the ON/OFF button to initiate activation. Upon hearing two beeps from the buzzer, proceed by tapping 'Continue' on the mobile interface to commence automatic network distribution. Upon successful distribution, you can utilize your mobile phone to operate the sauna.



#### **Warranty Information**

- The Sauna warrants its products to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- This warranty extends only to:

1.a retail purchaser of a sauna or parts directly from the **Revivex**;

- 2.the authorized wholesale purchaser of a sauna or parts directly from the **Revivex**; or
- 3. a retail purchaser of a sauna or parts from the supplier authorized wholesaler. However, in the event of a sale, transfer or conveyance of a sauna or parts from any of the three (3) proceeding persons or entities, any rights, duties and obligations associated with this warranty shall be null and void and of no further force and effect. The sauna or parts must be purchased and used within one year of the delivery date. The sauna or parts must be placed in an indoor environment unless the sauna or parts are specifically designed for outdoor use. If an indoor sauna or parts are placed in an outdoor environment, warranty shall be null and void and of no further force and effect. The controls, heaters, electrical parts and wiring must be kept dry at all times and not exposed to any water or liquids. The warranty begins on the original date of purchase, and is valid only on products purchased and used in the pointed market. To receive warranty service, the purchaser must contact the supplier for problem determination and service procedures. Warranty service can only be performed by the supplier authorized service center. The original dated bill of sale must be presented upon request as proof of purchase to the supplier or the supplier authorized service center. Inhome service will be provided during the warranty labor period subject to availability within the contiguous United States or Canada. In-home service is not available in all areas. To receive in- home service, the product must be unobstructed and accessible from floor level to service personnel. If during in-home service repair cannot be completed, it may be necessary to remove, repair and return the product. If in-home service is unavailable, the supplier may elect, at our option, to provide for transportation of our choice to and from the supplier authorized service center. Otherwise, transportation to and

from the supplier authorized service center is the responsibility of the purchaser.

This warranty covers manufacturing defects in materials and workmanship encountered in normal use of this product, and shall not apply to the following, including, but not limited to: damage which occurs in shipment; delivery and installation; applications and uses for which this product was not intended: altered product or serial numbers; cosmetic damage or exterior finish; accidents, abuse, neglect, fire, water, lightning or other acts of nature; use of products, equipment, systems, utilities, services, parts, supplies, accessories, applications, installations, repairs, external plumbing and leaks, external wiring, circuit breakers, fuses or connectors not supplied and authorized by the supplier, or which damage this product or result in service problems; incorrect electrical line voltage, fluctuations, and surges; customer adjustments and failure to follow operating instructions, cleaning, maintenance and environmental instructions that are covered and prescribed in the instruction book; consumable items including light bulbs.

The Sauna shall not be liable for the loss of use of the sauna or other incidental or consequential damages. Under no circumstances shall the supplier or any of its representatives be held liable for injury to any persons or damages to any properties. Specifications are subject to change without notice. The sauna uses the highest quality wood in our product lines. All structures using wood are susceptible to minor dents, scratches and scuffing. This is normal and will not affect the integrity or operation of your sauna.

Wood is a living material that continues to respond to climate conditions, even after being manufactured into a sauna

Variations in the color or grain, and irregularities such fine cracks are part of the natural beauty of the wood and in no way should be considered defects. During normal operation, wood may

crack slightly due to the changes in moisture level. This will not affect the structural integrity of the sauna.

Prior to shipping, the wood is inspected for consistency, color and quality. Our saunas are shipped around the globe, and can experience slight blemishes, scratches or scuffs in transit. In most cases, these blemishes on the exterior of the sauna can be concealed by using a small amount of furniture polish, oil or other furniture treatment. The interior blemishes, scratches, or scuffs can be either left alone, sanded or combination of gluing plus sanding. Please avoid any treatment containing benzene or a high concentration of alcohol.

ATTENTION: Shipping damage must be notated on the Bill of Lading (BOL). The Supplier must be notified of any damage to your sauna within three (3) business days of signing the BOL. Failure to notify the supplier within the established time frame will result in the owner taking full responsibility for cost of ALL REPLACEMENT PARTS including shipping and handling fees.
